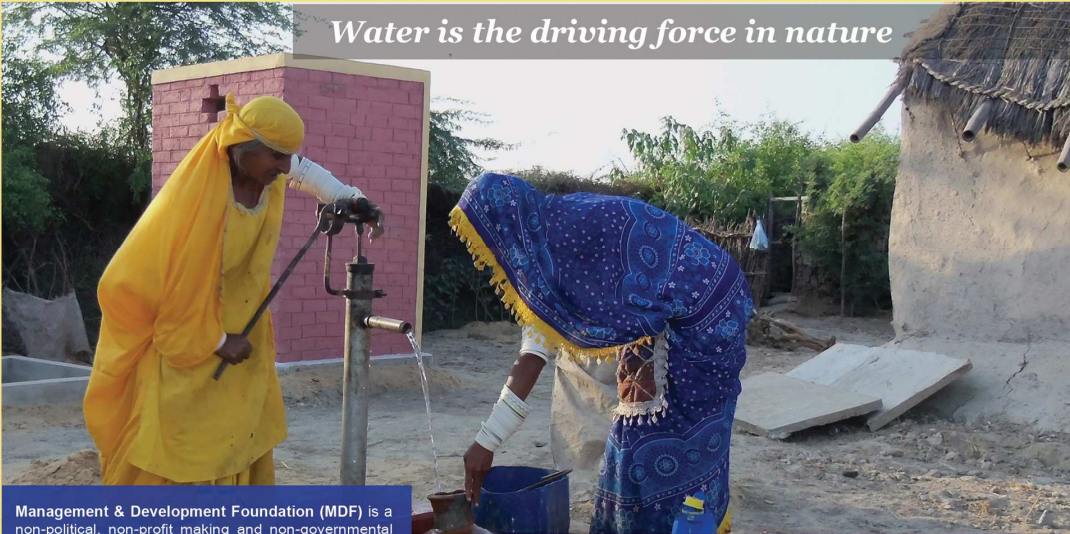

It provides quality and standardized services to the marginalized and deprived communities.

**Management and Development Foundation (MDF) is implementing the project "Village Development through Safe Drinking Water and Sanitation to Reduce Health Hazards" in Union Council Atta Muhammad Palli of Taluka/Tehsil and District Umerkot. Through this one year (2013-2014) scheme at least 1,700 families (3,400 male, 3,400 female and 5,600 children) of 27 villages will be facilitated with hand pumps and latrines.**

### Project Support Organization

Community Development Program (CDP) is an initiative of Government of Sindh to bring about improvement in the lives of ordinary people and mitigate poverty. The program is being executed through an independent and high powered Board under the Chairmanship of H.E. Dr. Shamsi Kassim Lakha. The composition of Board is self evident of the commitment which the Government of Sindh attaches to this initiative. The program is being implemented through renowned Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) using their expertise to bring about change in the development sector. Project Coordination Unit (PCU) serves as the Secretariat for Board and is entrusted to administer as well as monitor the program activities. The program was initiated in 2008-09 with the allocation of Rs.500 million which has been enhanced to Rs. 3 billion in ADP 2011-12. ### Project Key Activities

- ⊗ Deploy staff, establish office, and procure equipments and furniture;
- ⊗ Coordinate with relevant stakeholders;
- ⊗ Form 36 Community Development Organizations (CDOs);
- ⊗ Organize 108 health and hygiene sessions;
- ⊗ Plant 3,000 trees in targeted area;
- ⊗ Provide 300 hand pumps and 300 latrines;
- ⊗ Organize meetings with community/ CDO
- ⊗ Distribute 1,000 handbills and pamphlets for community sensitization.
- ⊗ 27 Water test (Villagewise)
- ⊗ Project impact assessment
- ⊗ Technical Report Fortnightly and Monthly
- ⊗ Monitor & submit progress report
- ⊗ Installation of 27 Village boards, 300 Latrines, 300 Handpumps Visibility Plate

### Project Expected Outcomes

- ⊗ Target women and children have more time for economic activities and education respectively while water is accessible at the doorstep;
- ⊗ Reduced open defecation, minimized health hazards and to some extent poverty is decreased, social status increased and economic opportunities augmented;
- ⊗ Tree plantation supported climate of target area;
- ⊗ Decreased water born diseases among community members especially children due to drinking safe and clean water; and
- ⊗ Capacity enhanced of community through notifying informing health and hygiene practices to secure from health hazards
